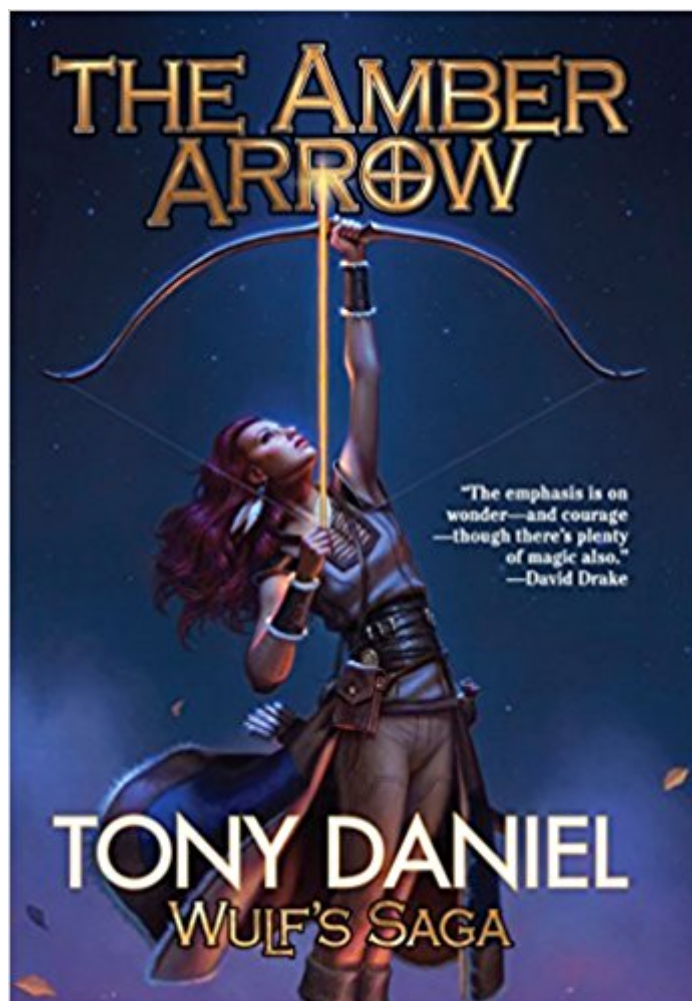

He is the coauthor, with David Drake, of General series entries *The Heretic* and *The Savior*. He is also the author of Star Trek Original Series novels *Devil's Bargain* and *Savage Trade*. Daniel is a Hugo finalist for his story "Life on the Moon," which also won the Asimov's Reader's Choice Award. Daniel's short fiction has been much anthologized and has been collected in multiple year's best compilations. Daniel has also cowritten screenplays for SyFy Channel and the Chiller Channel. During the early 2000s, he was the writer and director of numerous audio dramas for critically-acclaimed SCIFI.COM's Seeing Ear Theatre.
