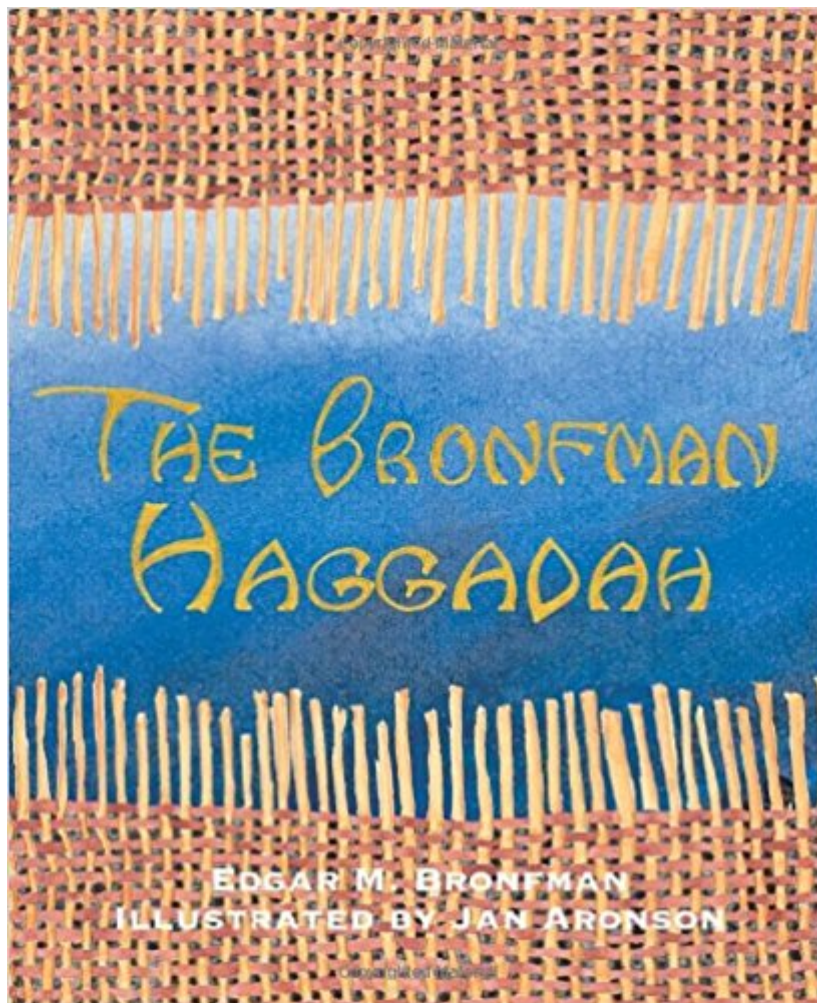

The Bronfman Haggadah



Synopsis

A beautifully illustrated contemporary Haggadah for the Passover Seder, as interpreted by the world-renowned philanthropist and Jewish leader Edgar M. Bronfman. This Haggadah will inspire and delight all ages. Designed to foster Jewish pride, Edgar Bronfman's text continues the traditional commandment to retell the Exodus story of slavery and freedom for future generations. The Haggadah teaches people of all ages about Judaism with a fresh perspective while helping to define Passover for everyone at the Seder table. The author's creative approach weaves together meaningful readings, from the nineteenth-century abolitionist Frederick Douglass to a lesser-known poet, Marge Piercy. Bronfman captures the young reader's imagination when each child, teenager, and adult assumes the role of a character in the Exodus story, or perhaps to become one of the story's narrators. Watercolor paintings, created specially for this book, illustrate its main parts: the Seder plate's symbolic foods, the parting of the Red Sea, the forty-year journey, the giving of the ten commandments on Mount Sinai, to name a few. The Bronfman Haggadah is a welcome addition for the avid collector, as well as to be used as the Haggadah of choice to enrich the Passover Seder experience with its refreshing interactive approach.

This is probably the most beautiful Haggadah you will ever see. It has no Hebrew, so be prepared for that. But in terms of sheer beauty, it is truly lovely, and deserves a place at your seder table.

These are beautiful haggadot, but they lack Hebrew. normally, this would not be a problem, but they lack the bare minimum (like the translation of the 10 plagues). i will be using them this Passover. the pictures are mesmerizing and the story is wonderfully written. kudos to bronfman and aronson!

We used parts of the Bronfman Haggadah in our Passover Seder, as their information expanded our knowledge. Their point of view about the key importance of the Exodus is fascinating. Especially appreciate their respect for people's varying sensibilities when referring to the meaning of G-d.

This is a rare find, and we are absolutely thrilled with it!!! As a matter of fact we brought it to a Passover seder and invited all the guests to look at it with supervision. The wedding of artwork with the text was simply magnificent, and the messages are very timely and relevant.

The Bronfman Haggadah is beautifully illustrated and for those just looking for a lovely book to give as a gift to somebody completely unfamiliar with Passover rituals, it could work well. However, I found it much too simplistic to be a working Haggadah for even a largely secular seder.

Very pretty Haggadah. It has a different and interesting take on Passover, but won't use it for Seder as I prefer a more traditional one for that.
