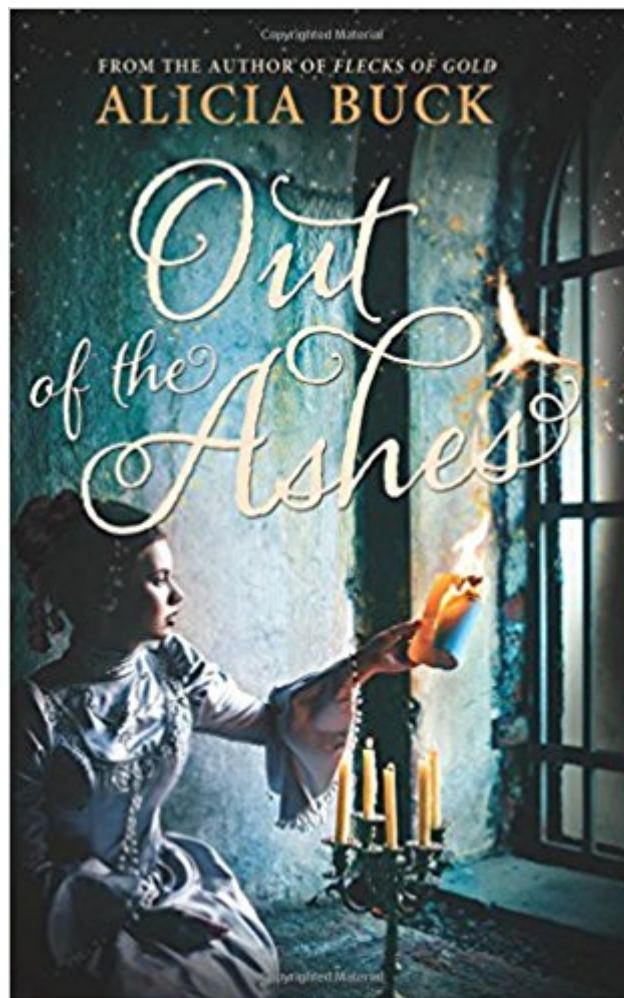

She does a fantastic job on the world building in both of her books. "*Out of the Ashes*" is based off Cinderella which traditionally makes it an instant-love story, where two characters who know nothing about each other fall in love because the other is just so good looking. Alicia Buck does well here though. The romantic parts of her stories are not artificial or sappy, rather, though there is attraction from the start, she has the romance develop more realistically over time and you get to know the characters and connect with them and see their reasons for liking each other or not based solely on physical appearance. I took of one star only because I felt like the writing wasn't exceptional at first. It wasn't bad, but the

beginning, before the father dies, just didn't seem to flow right. The dialogue with the father just felt . . off. Once the story got going though the writing started to flow more naturally, and I felt was it was quite good from then on.

I love this book. I'm a great fan of fantasy books and I'll read anything from Harry Potter to Maximum Ride, but I also have a love for fairy tales. Some my favorite books from that genre are Ella Enchanted and Fairest, and this author has managed to capture my heart as well. I love that this fairy has the beautiful scene of prince saving the girl, but also has such a strong female character that if the prince hadn't shown up she would have still lived happily ever after. Ashelandra is a strong, mischievous character who is easy to connect to, though most of us can't spit out sorcery every now and then. The author easily gets you wrapped into the story and more than once I had to be reminded to put the book down so I could do my classwork. Its a beautiful story and I'd highly recommend this book to anyone who loves a fairy tale or an adventure book with a nice side of romance.
