My only complaint with the book, and it's not enough to lose even a part of a star over, is that the pictures all approach the models as completed works of art (which they are). I would have loved to have seen an additional page or two at the end of each mech deconstructing one or two of the signature parts into their Lego components, just to give us more inspiration on how these were constructed. There are so many places that I can look at the parts and tell they are Lego, but can't tell what parts or how it was built to give that specific look - it would be nice to get some hints as to how he made them. Again, an amazing display of ingenuity captured in a series of pictures I'm sure our family will spend countless hours pouring over. Highly recommended!
