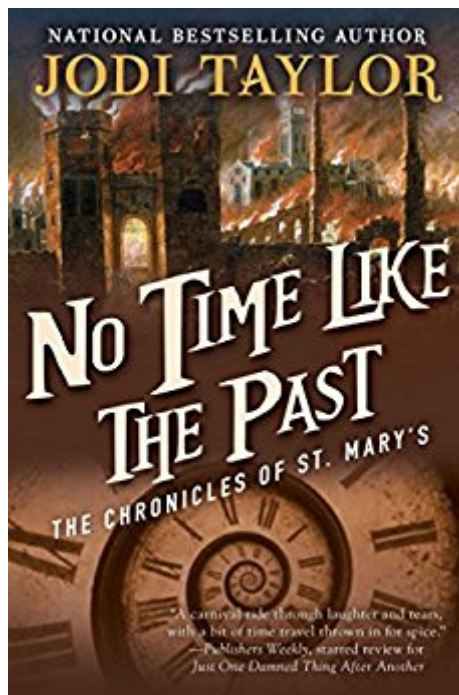




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No Time Like The Past: The Chronicles Of St. Mary's Book Five (The Chronicles Of St Mary's 5)
