

British novelist Charles Dickens was born on February 7, 1812, in Portsmouth, England. Over the course of his writing career, he wrote the beloved classic novels—Oliver Twist, A Christmas Carol, Nicholas Nickleby, David Copperfield, A Tale of Two Cities—and Great

Expectations. On June 9, 1870, Dickens died of a stroke in Kent, England, leaving his final novel, *The Mystery of Edwin Drood*, unfinished. Jerry Robbins, co-founder of the Colonial Radio Theatre on the Air has written and produced over 350 radio plays, including *Ticonderoga*, *Captain Blood*, *The Legend of Sleepy Hollow*, *Gettysburg*, *Treasure Island*, *Yankee Clipper*, *Powder River*, and *Little Big Horn*. In 2006 he started a collaboration with legendary author Ray Bradbury, producing *Dandelion Wine*, followed by *Something Wicked This Way Comes*, and wrote the script for, and produced *The Halloween Tree*; all award winning productions that garnered high praise from the master himself. He is currently working on a fourth collaboration with Mr. Bradbury, a radio dramatization of *The Martian Chronicles*. These radio recordings are very enjoyable adaptations of several Charles Dickens Christmas stories, however it is very misleading to have the listing describe these as unabridged. It would be more accurate to state that these are the complete radio broadcast recordings, which I assume they are. The stories are most certainly abridged. For instance, if you are a fan of Scrooge's nephew Fred, you will be very disappointed. He appears only in his visit to Scrooge's office on Christmas Eve; there is no visit by Scrooge and the Ghost of Christmas Present to Fred's home. The edit was most likely made so that the broadcast fit into the permitted air time, but it is a significant abridgement. Similarly, key story elements from *The Cricket on the Hearth* are missing. I did buy the unabridged audiobook to get more story information! The recordings themselves are entertaining as I said. The voice actors are skilled and bring the stories to life. I enjoyed adding these recordings to my holiday listening. I just wanted to warn that the recordings are dramatizations of the stories and are most certainly abridged.
