Born in Saint-Domingue, in a long struggle for independence Toussaint led enslaved Africans and Afro-Haitians to victory over French colonisers, abolished slavery, and secured French control over the colony, Haiti. Nick Nesbitt is Professor of French at Princeton University. He is the editor of *Toussaint Louverture: The Haitian Revolution* co-editor of *Sounding the Virtual: Gilles Deleuze and the Philosophy of Music*, and author of *Universal Emancipation: The Haitian Revolution and the Radical Enlightenment*, a study of the political ontology of the Haitian Revolution, and *Voicing Memory: History and Subjectivity in French Caribbean Literature*, a study of Antillean literature and black Atlantic critical theory.
