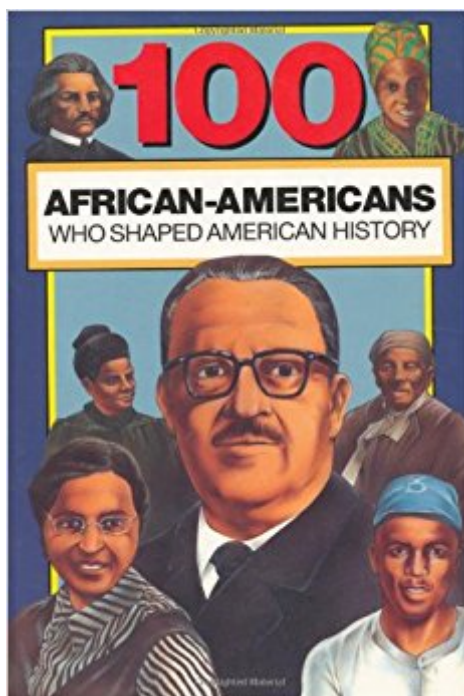

The stories are short and very informational, we are really enjoying this read. The fact that it has pictures of each person really help put a face to the name. The reading level is perfect for my 11 year old. He has to look up some words which is helping him better understand the read and learn new words. Also practicing looking up things.

This book needs to be updated because some of these people such as Muhammad Ali, Maya Angelou, and Shirley Chisholm are no longer with us. Other than this minor discrepancy, this book can be used as a wonderful reference source pertaining to prominent African Americans. This book is a good starting point for anybody, regardless of age, who are thirsty for knowledge of black history, or a more complete narrative of American history.
