

These 6 interconnected stories have some characters from GWS 1 books and many new ones. There is still a lot of action and very complex characters who deal with some major issues. I loved them all, but I have to say that I loved Kipling the best. That was the last story and not as long as the others, but I was anxiously awaiting his happy ever after. This was a great ending for both the first and the second series as they both show up here I got both series as Kindle bundles that were well worth it, in my opinion. If you like lots of action, former military characters, and emotionally complex issues, then I think you would like these. Try the non-Texas one, since that is the first series. Chances are good that if you do, you will be getting this one next! Enjoy!

The biggest surprise I had gotten in this series was when I continued to read.....I am so glad I did but maybe it would be better if I'd read the other series first. The other grey security series that turns out is the first. Well, I loved these soooo much I'm back to reading more of this authors work as soon as I can. Truly awesome. The stories, the characters....everything was sooo much, and at the same time not enough when it ended. I felt like I wanted to slip into this world and remain forever inside. The fact that I spent the whole day glued to the screen reading this should tell you something. 6 books in one day. Awesome for me, not so good for my house.

I'm only at 9 percent and already the "c" word for a woman's mound has been used several times. There aren't many words I find as repulsive as that one. It takes me out of the story, so far out that I'm here rather than reading the rest of the scene. So far the story is good, but I won't remember it or the author that way. I finished the first book. It was good, but not enough to overcome my previous objection and one other I'll add. The "prologue" should read "spoiler alert". I won't be reading any more prologues by this author as they make no sense to me. That word I find so repulsive was in every book. I skimmed the intimate scenes and put my finger over that word so I wouldn't see it in my peripheral vision, as I was trying to find the end of the scene. The plots were good, but she needs a better editor. Clique is a snarky group of girls in junior high school not a shortened form of the word kilometer which is klick. There were many others, but I'm not sure Ms Sinclair really cares.

Each story takes a member of the new security firm finding love . Most of the team are working different cases. All of the members have some type of military history or government intelligence. All the stories tie together very nicely keeping you invested until the end of series. I found moments of emotion suspension, horror, fear, and joy with relief by the end of it book. I would love to have an epilogue to see further in to everyone's future.

These were ok, for being part of the kindle unlimited package I am ok with them. There were 6 books with a different couple at the center. The head of the firm has chapters in all of the books and that kind of annoyed me to be honest. You do have to throw believability out the window to grasp that 6 employees all fall in love within like 3 weeks of each other. They were an easy read, nothing complicated. Not overly raunchy or steamy but did some sex scenes.

I liked the premise of love conquers all in the books. The books are well written and they move smoothly. The suspense builds as one thing after another keeps the bodyguards and their clients a step away from disaster. The men and women from Gray Wolf Security have some heartache in their pasts. They come together like a big family, meddling with the best of intentions, and always there to catch the one who falls. Each book has a happy ever after ending, lots of hot sex, and love forever. They are fun to read. Watch out for David's cameras, they're everywhere you don't want them to be, catching some hot times.

I have read three of this author's collections and I'm just done. I do not believe Ms. Sinclair has any actual expansion with military or law enforcement, nor does she bother to find an expert to consult with. The way she skips over, through and around procedures is too much to allow me to suspend my disbelief which is critical to enjoying any story. There are many instances in these books where a decision or action is necessary to the storyline but is ridiculous coming from an experienced veteran--especially of spec ops! Finally, the author NEEDS AN EDITOR! I simply cannot take one more weary or weariness when wary or wariness is clearly meant. Misspellings and entire word displacement, added and missing words are pretty common throughout. I read 3 collections for less than \$1 each but the price was the only reason I read anything after the first. The character development is nonexistent, the pace too fast to believe, the sex scenes repetitive and too forgettable with sometimes ridiculous timing story-wise. That said, if you want a cheap, quick read--these qualify. But they are not always light, though the GWS books do give HEA to all. Overall I found them barely adequate as entertainment.
