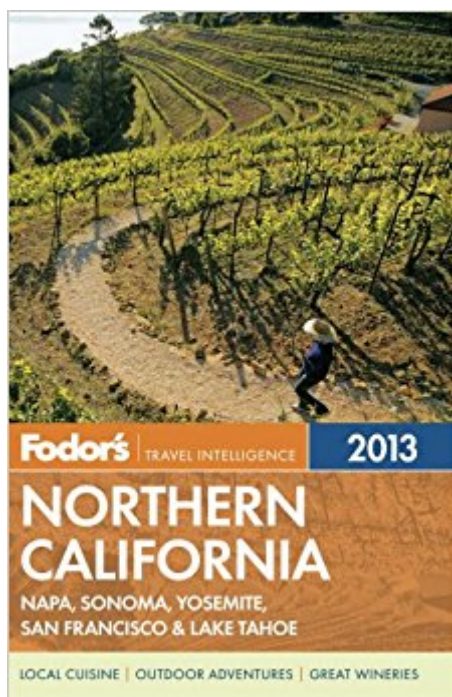

I ordered this because it was the only Fodors Guide that covers Lake Tahoe. It had only one small chapter on the area. Therefore, most of the book and the map were useless to me. The one chapter was very informative and contained lots of great tips for sightseeing. However, a more in depth book for the Lake Tahoe and surrounding area would have been ideal.

It also has tons of info on Central California which I did not need. Actually about 50 pages applies to my trip and the map is useless because it is too small to give the detail I need. Fodor's is known for great guides and this certainly fits the bill. It has some really good maps, neat, off the path info, and some amazing photos. Not essential to a good time in N. Cali, but certainly added some good elements to the trip.
