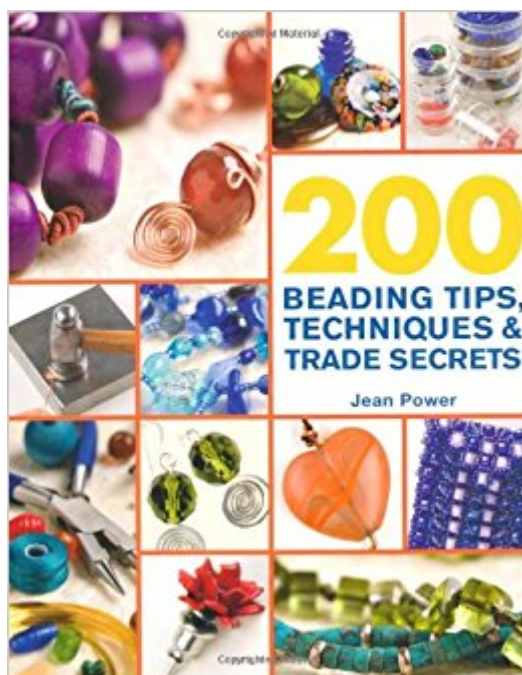

Having been involved with beading several years now, I am the first to admit that I have not always made the right choices in beading books. No so with this purchase; I am thoroughly enjoying this book. It explores many techniques and is a great resource for beginner and experienced beader alike. The photos and instructions are clear. This book was a great purchase as a beginner. I shares a lot of information about different types of beads, tools, & other equipment. Offers cost saving other tips that are great to know upfront when getting started. It is easy to understand, well written & has a lot of photos & information. I'm not sure how useful it would be for someone with experience but for a beginner this is a great reference.

I've done some beading/jewelry making and have collected several books along the years. This one book has given me more practical information and detailed instruction than any one other. With lots of color photographs, the instructions for patterns like the St. Petersburg chain are so easy to follow.
