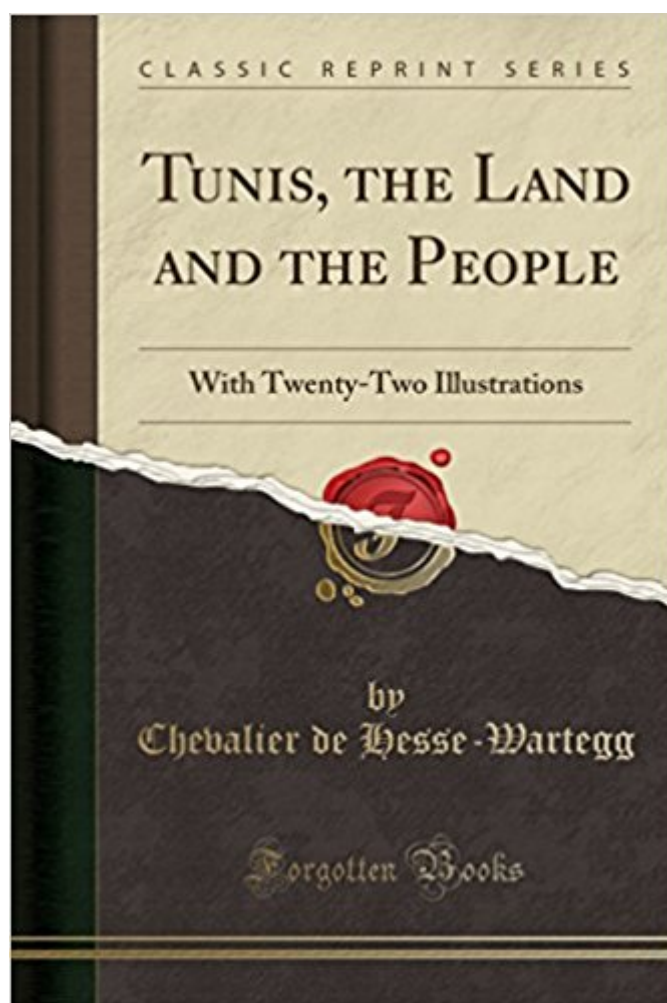


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Tunis, The Land And The People: With Twenty-Two Illustrations (Classic Reprint)
