

This is a good story. However, I purchased it for a unit on Cinderella type stories for my second grade class. The book is too advanced for them. I would recommend it for teens and adults. Advanced 4th and 5th grade students can also enjoy it.

I brought this book for my daughter and she had already read it 3 times. She loves the story line and it's a very easy read.

Ye Xian is a young Chinese girl, who lost her mother when she was young, and her father married a stepmother. Her step mother loathes her, and although other adults say that her stepmother just does mean things since she wants to control Ye Xian, Ye Xian doesn't believe in those words, and the condition between them rapidly turns into severe hatred. The only joy of Ye Xian was visiting her big aunt, and she was the one who recommended the new English name (Chinese Cinderella to describe her situation) to her. However, even that came to a halt after she left on an "urgent

business" to an island far away. Afterwards, she came to biting on her stepmother (it was self-defense) and her father got so mad that he picked Ye Xian up like a kitten, and threw her out the front door, never wanting her to come back again. While lost and angry, Ye Xian remembered there was still hope for her, and that she previously got a card which said "we help the opposed and the downtrodden" in it, so she went to visit the place mentioned in the handout, and from then, her life changed: from an innocent girl with rough start at life to a full-time member of the dragon society of wandering knights. The book's progress is graduate, fast if it was a long novel, but normal for a short book (depends on how you read it), and it really is action packed, and overflowing with intensity and excitement. The character progressions are well times, and there is, in my opinion, not a single nick in the story. I really enjoyed this book, and I hope you, and everyone else would too, after reading. I recommend it to everyone who is interested in destinies, and Chinese kung-fu actions.
