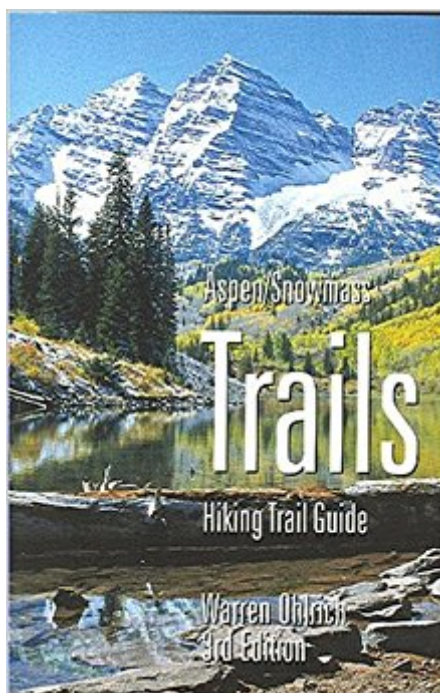

Stretching west from the Continental Divide through the Hunter–Frying Pan Wilderness, Collegiate Peaks Wilderness, and the Maroon Bells–Snowmass Wilderness, these trails access a wide variety of lakes, mountain passes, stream valleys, forests, and high country in one of the most beautiful mountainous regions in the Rockies. The guide features hikes from 1 hour to 5 days, trails accessible by foot or bus from Aspen, distance/elevation graphs, GPS coordinates, a quick reference list of all trails, accurate directions to trailheads, wilderness ethics and regulations, a guide for day hike variations, and a foldout map of trail routes.

Warren Ohlrich is very familiar with the mountains and trails around his home near Aspen, Colorado. As an outdoorsman and athlete, he has hiked, run, skied, and snowshoed these thirty trails many times. He has also written other summer and winter guide books which detail additional trails in the Roaring Fork Valley and nearby areas.

The author chose excellent hikes-- I've done several, and they were all as described. The write-ups are concise, trail-head directions easy to follow, and I love the elevation profiles. This book is well organized by trail length, so I can easily flip to the length I'm looking for that day or that trip, and plan accordingly!

It contains the a major hikes and is a little brief in the descriptions. Would recommend it for the casual hiker only.

I like the concise format of the book and trail descriptions. The book is small and easily fits into a day back or jacket pocket. I would prefer simple trail maps to the altitude graph for each trail and a simple map showing driving directions would be a useful reference when trying to find the trailhead. The full trail map of the area in the back cover of the book is much appreciated.
