

Treema is ready to leave NORA behind forever, but NORA is far from done with her. With the hope of a life ahead with Vance, she pushes onward through the uninhabitable dessert. After losing all her gear, it seems like she'll never make it, but is saved by a hidden underground settlement. Vance doesn't know that Treema is on her way to join him, but he is up to his elbows in his own problems. After agreeing to be put on trial for his previous actions, he's become a prisoner of his own people. Vance and Treema are creating their own paths in this second book. They want to be together, but first must overcome obstacles in their own lives and find each other again afterwards. I enjoyed seeing Treema and Vance in their own stories as they struggled with different problems. Now that Treema can no longer turn her back on NORA, it's citizens, and all the problems right in front of her, she will have to fight even harder for what she believes is right. For Vance it was never a question of if he should or should not help others, but without having the power to lead or change situations, he will have quite a difficult time of it! This story picks up right where the first one leaves off and ends with quite the chaotic climax.

I liked the way Treema and Vance have grown in this second book. Both characters are developing and becoming the best version of themselves despite having to survive the desert and its hidden dangers. Betrayal is their constant companion but they will never give up fighting to save their people. Vance and Treema are victims of circumstances beyond their control and it will be interesting to see if they can find a way to be together and still save their people.

Treema and Vance are separated, but want to reunite in this second installment in the Numbers

Game Trilogy. Before they can find one another, they each have to go through some hard trials. I feel that their determination to be together shows their commitment to one another. Treena finds out what life is like beyond the borders of NORA's city. Traveling through the dry wasteland of the country she is injured, but thankfully found by a community hiding underground. She joins their community while recuperating, but always has her thoughts centered on finding Vance again. While there, she learns more about NORA and the outlands. Vance has taken responsibility for his actions against his community, but is surprised by the criminal charges brought to him by the outlanders. They accuse him of things that aren't true, but won't listen to the truth. He finds out that the people in charge have their own reasons for wanting the community to not believe and support Vance. He has to do what is necessary to protect himself, those he cares about, and the community as a whole. Vance and Treena reunite right in the middle of chaos. I don't want to spoil what happens, but you will want to read to find out! I felt that Treena really grew stronger throughout the book. She has some hard challenges in front of her leading into the last book of the series and it will be interesting to see how she handles things from her situation.

Great follow up to Numbers Game. We take up where we left off in Number Game - and there is a whole lot of things wrong in the world that Treena and Vance need to address. Treena and Vance are separated as the description of the book states, but don't worry about that. These two are the most resourceful forces of nature that this dystopian world has seen. Rebecca Rode writes a very well paced, character driven story that poses the question that if there was another great civil war in America and if one faction won out over the other and adopted a Ratings systems that is strictly adhered to by all citizens - what would life be like. But knowing human nature and the nature of most Americans - not everyone is going to be onboard with the new system. So these people will live in the wilderness and hide from the "Great City" and risk capture at every turn. This second book focuses on those people and what has become of the wilderness outside of the Great City walls - we see it from the points of view of Treena and Vance and they fight and struggle against nature, injustice, and against one human varmint that I wanted to Gibbs Slap all the way down to South America. Highly recommend reading this book, the first book, Numbers Games and the additional books Ruby's Story and Chan's Story. I read the first 2 books almost in 1 setting and I am eagerly looking forward to book number 3.....hurry Rebecca, the suspense is killing me!!!

Opening line: "I stood on the threshold of an abandoned stucco building and reached out, fingering a flake of orange-pink paint on the splintering wood." It had been awhile since I read book 1 so it took

me a couple of chapters to remember what happened so I recommend reading the books in order. What a ride! Treena and Vance are at it again: adventures, leading people and romance. They each have their own chapters and what is going on in their lives until they meet again right before the biggest obstacle. Vance is caught and held as a prisoner. He's accused of treason. Treena was injured on her way to find Vance and is kept underground until she's well enough to leave. I got so caught up in the story I almost finished in one setting. There were enough suspenseful moments to keep me reading. I wanted the good guys to win and the bad guys to be stopped.

I REALLY enjoyed the first book, Numbers Game. This second book, while good, was not as good as the first one. I will continue to read the series if more books are published (which I'm assuming by the way this one ends) because the overall premise is good and the writing style flows. Although, I find that the 2nd book/movie is usually a little lacking and trying to get the reader to the next part of the story. This book felt like that.
