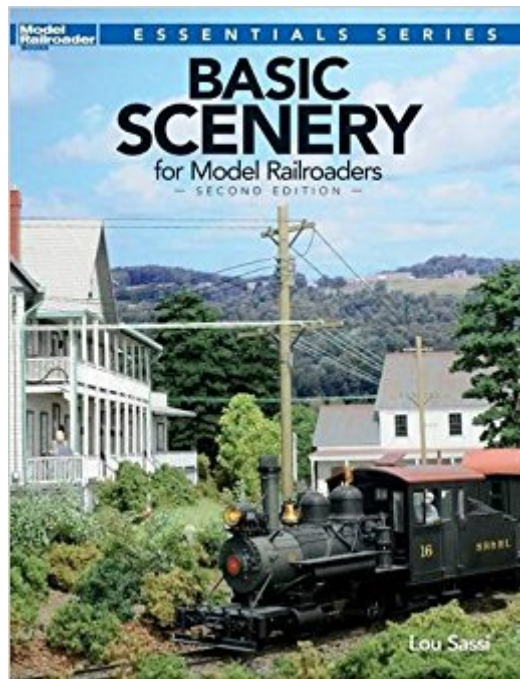

He started building his HO scale Boston & Maine West Hoosic Division Railroad, which was featured in July 1988 *Model Railroader*, 1999 *Great Model Railroads*, and Allen Keller's *Great Model Railroad* video #23. In 2008, Lou dismantled the West Hoosic Division, and he and his wife, Cheryl, moved to Raleigh, North Carolina, to be nearer their oldest son, Adam, his wife, Lynne, and their two children, Heather and Joshua. Lou is working on an O-30 layout based on Maine's two-foot gauge Sandy River & Rangeley Lakes Railroad.
