

There were certainly slow parts of this book I didn't care for, but overall it was an interesting, intimate look into Poitier's life, with much devoted to lessons he wants to share with his grandchild. One of my favorite snippets is where he talks about money, and putting money in perspective, not letting the acquisition of it consume you: "Over much of your upcoming years, money will command your attention. Allow it a proper place in your life, but deny it a throne." Something to remember when money, not happiness, becomes too much of a focus.

Poitier delivers this wonderful memoir by way of letters to his infant great-granddaughter. Somehow, he was able to weave into this book a beautiful mix of philosophy, his life experiences, offerings of wisdom, and descriptions of himself as an individual -- all directed toward, not just his great-granddaughter, but to any and all of us. I especially enjoyed his descriptions and stories about his youth -- born and raised on Cat Island Bahamas, then to Nassau, then to NY City, and on to his Hollywood career. Poignant! Eloquently written. Memorable. All this from a man who was (and I

stress WAS) uneducated and lived a totally isolated childhood where he knew love in abundance, but knew nothing of the world that existed beyond a small area of an tiny island. I was fascinated by the fact that he didn't know what he looked like until his late teens (forget exact age), as he had never seen a mirror. A compelling read -- sometimes light, often deep, always interesting.

Some pretty interesting reflections from a self-made man that became one of the greatest actors of the twentieth century while breaking down racial barriers and stereotypes that were pervasive during that time in our country. It took him decades of struggles to become the generally beloved and respected figure we know today. Thoughtfully written. Would Recommend to all ages high school and above.
