

This is one of a series of books for dementia or Alzheimer's patients, seniors with trouble reading and others who would benefit with 'easy read' books that are formatted for adults. Three Things offers self-esteem and self-confidence to former bookworms who now struggle with "regular" books in regard to both length and content. You'll know that you're buying a book that is much easier for a dementia or Alzheimer's patient to follow, however your loved one will only know that he/she is receiving a book that has no stress attached while being an eye-catching addition to their collection. Neither the title nor any text on or in the book states that the book is for dementia or any type of memory/cognitive problems; It is truly concealed so that the reader is not insulted. 'Disguised' as a 'regular' book, a senior reader will have: A lovely "easy read" story without condescending childlike words. Perfect, slightly larger text (16x font). 7 Short chapters. Short paragraphs. One extra space between each sentence to encourage the mind to take pause. 2 to 3 gorgeous full-color photos per each chapter to give a visual clue to the subject matter without distracting the read. Three Things is a humorous, happy read that centers on a woman's journey to follow her adult daughter's advice: Look around and surely you can find 3 things that are wonderful. What starts as a reluctant walk in a circle around the neighborhood turns into a delightful venture. Your senior reader will discover simple joys along the way; a young boy playing in the rain, a gorgeous bluebird and a pair of comically charming wild rabbits. The book finishes with an amusing conversation between mother and daughter.

If you have a loved one with Alzheimer's disease, dementia or senior reading troubles, this book is just what you've been looking for. Other books in this series include: Autumn's Display, Down by the Meadow, What the Wind Showed to Me, The Sandy Shoreline and A Dusting of Snow.

This is a short story split into several chapters and accompanied by full color pictures that actually go along with the story, which I really like. My nana loved the other chapter books I bought by this author, and now we have them all! She is still able to read short paragraphs on most days and I believe these books really complement the brain activities her doctor has her do to help with the symptoms of Alzheimer's.

I work as an In-home Caregiver, primarily working with senior citizens living with Dementia. I am always looking for activities that are fun and cognitively stimulating for my clients. I loved the premise surrounding this book, one of several books on this "reading level" by this author. I was so very disappointed when this purchase arrived. The book is thinner than an elementary school child's chapter book. The writing style is chapter book style. The print is an average (smaller) font. The paper used in this paperback is cheap and flimsy (not easy for elder fingers to turn.) The colorful picture MAY be colorful but it is hard to tell because they are so minuscule (approx. 3"x4") that they are hard to see. For the exorbitant price, I had hoped for an excellently developed product. Sadly, I had to return this book...too many flaws in user friendliness. Not worth the price.

My mother in law who has dementia in the middle stages loves this book. It's easy to read and understand, and she even left a note for me saying that it lifted her spirits on a day when she was down in the dumps. Hope there will be more books like this coming out.
