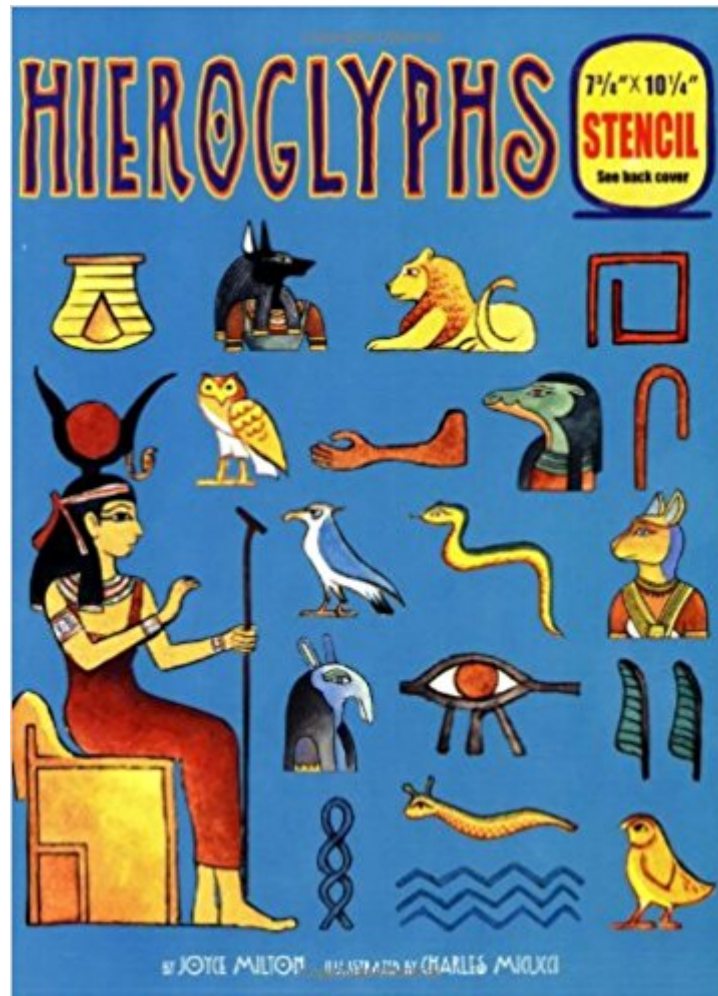

I don't know why, but I had really high expectations for this book. However, the "directions" are pretty vague. Also, my book came completely trashed. It has rips all over it and was just in really bad condition for a new book. It MIGHT have been from shipping but even so, it should have probably been packaged better then! Even with the damage it was easy to read. I don't agree that it's really for "5 year olds", though. If there had been better directions in this book I would have easily given it 5 stars. However, they get away with not having to really give too many directions by

saying "there is no right way." That's fine, but it's a little confusing. The stencil is a nice addition and mostly why I bought it. I have had a little experience with hieroglyphics over the years so perhaps I was expecting too much from this. My oldest kid had absolutely no interest in it right NOW but if they get into this subject later in school then they will probably love this book as an addition to my other hieroglyphics books. For the price, it's not too bad, though.

Nice short book on ancient Egyptian life and language. Great for kids and young teens. Explains basic hieroglyphs. Comes with a stencil of 24 hieroglyphs that kids can use to form words and to write "secret" messages to their pals, but does not include a colored pencil to use with the stencil. Careful opening the back cover to remove the stencil; mine ripped while removing it.

My 5th grader grabbed this book out of the box as soon as it came. Within 15 minutes, she was completely engrossed. Def recommended for kids who are studying Ancient Egypt.
