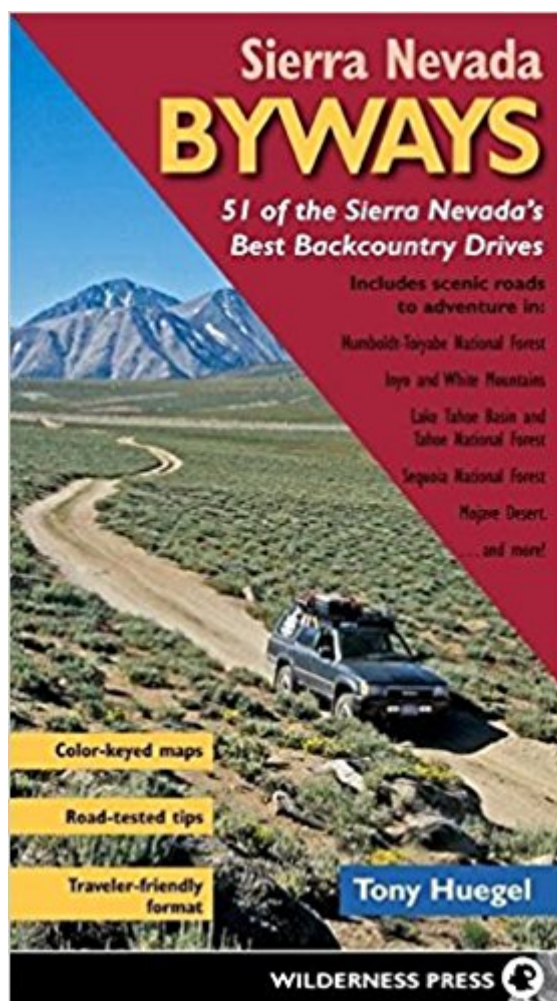


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Sierra Nevada Byways: 51 Of The Sierra Nevada's Best Backcountry Drives (Backcountry Byways)
