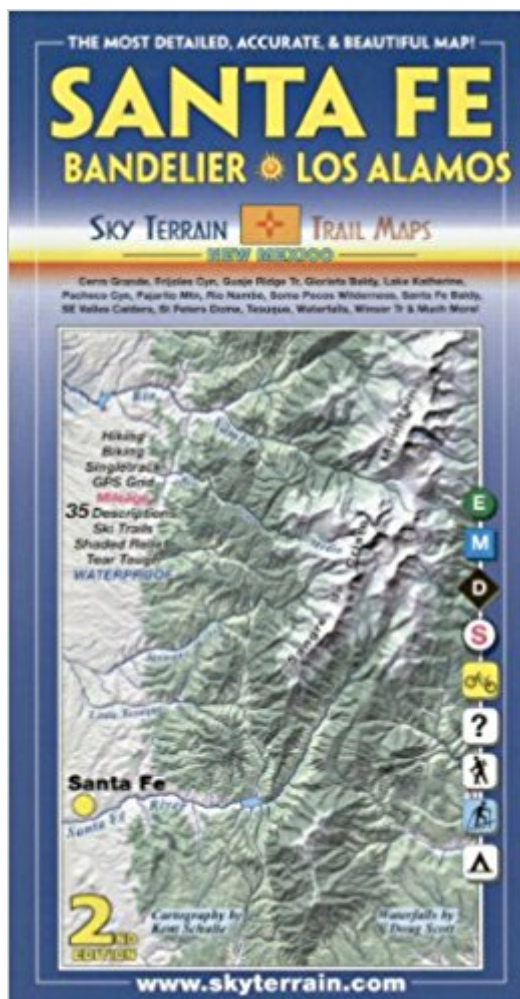

Synopsis

Very detailed and beautiful topographic trail map covers the area from historic downtown Santa Fe up to the high mountains of the Sangre de Cristo. The second side shows Bandelier National Mounument, including the famous cliff dwellings and the perfect canyons; and Los Alamos as well as the Jemez Mountains and a chunk of the Valle Caldera National Preserve. Custom shaded relief reveals the terrain in a new light. Trails are rated, trailheads & singletrack marked, mileage shown. UTM lines for GPS. Roads rated for biking. Informative trail descriptions included. Updated, and numerous waterfalls added. Printed on waterproof paper; folds to 4 by 8 inches.

I'm visiting Los Alamos in August to go mountain bike riding. I bought this trail map to find all the rides around the area. It is tear resistant, waterproof (which is good because August is monsoon season) and has all the mountain bike trails labelled and easy to spot. The bike shops in Santa Fe (There aren't any in Los Alamos) recommend this as the best comprehensive bike map for the area.

Great Map! Even organizes trails according to how you use them (mtn biking, xcountry skiing, etc.)

The map is very useful and told me what I needed to know about Santa Fe and the surrounding

area.

I took this on the trail with me for a first time trip to Santa Fe. It was a huge help for figuring out the trails, mileage between points and generally giving me a comfort level that I was on right trail.

This colorful, water-resistant map is clear, easy to follow, and neat and compact for carrying. It had all the main trails I wanted to know about, already marked in yellow.

Nice map. I like these maps printed on a "waterproof" paper and even though Santa Fe is in the desert, I ended up being there during 3 days of rain and this map held up great.

I bought this map primarily hoping for coverage of the DOE trails south of White Rock and the Caja del Rio area between Santa Fe and Bandelier/Los Alamos, since I already have decent maps of Bandelier and Los Alamos proper. Unfortunately, the map covers three discontinuous areas, and the Los Alamos area doesn't even go far enough east to cover all the Los Alamos trails, let alone White Rock. The description is deceptive:: it definitely does not "cover the area from historic downtown Santa Fe up to the high mountains of the Sangre de Cristo" but leaves a huge gap between those two areas. Too bad, because it really is a beautiful map (hence the 4 star rating -- would have been 5 if not for the deceptive description) and excellent for the areas it does cover. I'd definitely buy a version that covered all of Los Alamos county and the Caja del Rio if they made one.
