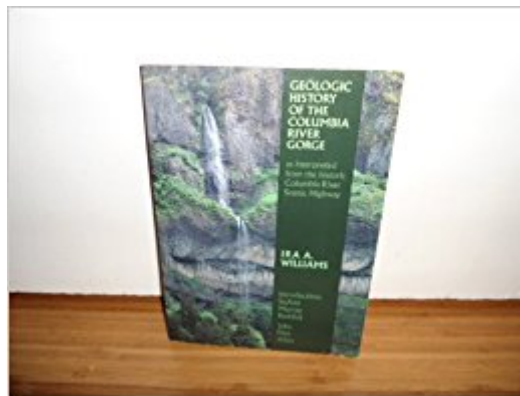

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This is an excellent and well-written book on the geology of the Columbia River Gorge. Originally written in 1916, shortly after the Historic Columbia River Highway was opened, it has been updated since then to include more recent geological discoveries.
