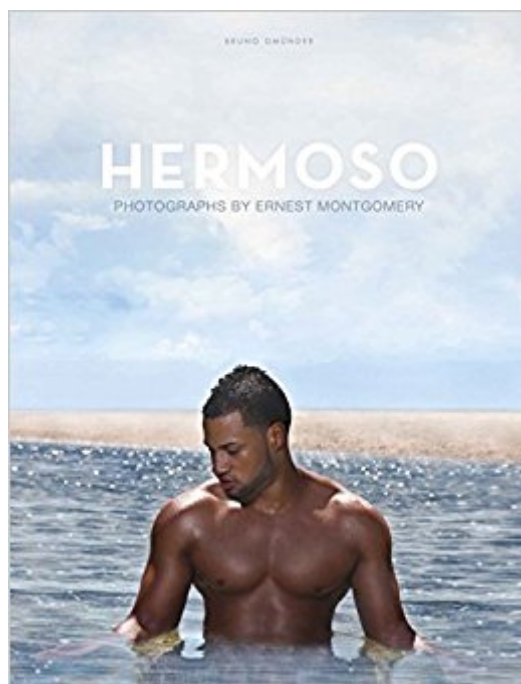

As the Forward by Terrance Dean states, *Hermoso* is a Spanish word meaning handsome, beautiful. It is an aesthetic one embodies and possesses naturally.
