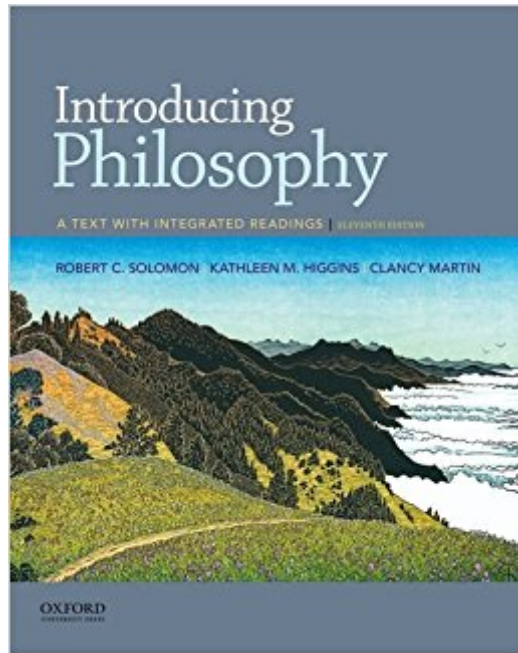

As its name implies, it is an introductory textbook and therefore doesn't go amazingly in-depth on any one single philosophical view. The textbook is not dry at all, and the context it tries to provide for the included texts are very helpful to understanding the meaning and purpose behind the philosopher's ideas.
